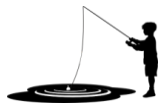

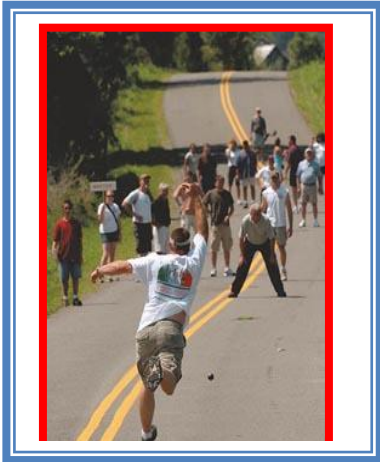
# IRISH ROAD BOWLING CONTEST

Saturday, July 12

Catholic Charities Way off Weldon Road, Oak Ridge, NJ  
(Weigand Farms - Dept for Persons with Disabilities) at 2 PM

**WHAT IS ROAD BOWLING?** The alley is a country road approximately one mile long, and it is not officially closed so it's important to stay alert for vehicles! There will be no improvements made to the road; and the road will be played "as is" - uphill, downhill, and winding. There's no stopping the ball when it's moving so watch out for rocks and holes. And there are no bumpers along the edge of the roadway on either side. The "bowl" is small, black and dense about the size of a baseball but six times as heavy weighing 1 lb. 12 oz. The bowler is allowed to throw it however he/she sees fit, but the most common approach is basically an underhand fast-pitch softball throw with a running start. Team members will throw the ball in rotation as listed on their entry letter. The team who takes the least number of throws to complete the course (similar to scoring for golf) will be declared the winner. In case of a tie, there will be a play-off.

**NEEDED:** Teams consisting of 4 members each - male, female, or combined - all participants must be at least 16 years of age to play. Entry fee of \$10 per team, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place medals to be awarded.
